Mission




To empower individuals of all abilities and backgrounds through sailing.

They started teaching children to sail in remote fishing communities, sharing their stories and promoting sailing as a way to provide new life opportunities.

They discovered a growing community of Inclusive Sailing Programs with similar missions, and so they created a Network to collaborate and increase their impact and visibility.



Sailing can be expensive, sailing schools are often conservative and enclosed communities, and the knowledge and expertise are concentrated in specific regions.

Connected programs will get **benefits** and **opportunities** in the sailing world, like discounts from related brands and partner organizations.




Make Them Sailors is a foundation registered in the Netherlands and as of 2024 also in the US, where it has 501(c) status, which means it can receive tax-deductible donations.
